Tips for Parents

Get the whole family involved in with just a few easy steps:

- **Demonstrate:** Teach children the best way to reduce energy waste at home. There are different ways to reduce energy waste in your home, from behavioural adjustments to extensive home improvements. Show them how their behaviour can impact and reduce energy waste.
- Develop Understanding: explain to children that there are two main reasons for saving energy at home: saving money on bills and protecting the environment. With this, children will know the reasons why they have to change their habits and will see the benefit to making these changes.
- Provide Opportunities: saving energy requires changing certain habits in people. Getting used to doing certain tasks daily can be tricky at first; so, support children to change their habits by taking small steps – one change at a time – and reminding them to be patient. Small changes take time to have a big impact, but it is definitely worth it!
- Discuss: discuss energy waste with children and answer any questions they may have. Inform them that now is the best time to start to conserving energy, and remember, be consistent and in the end, you will notice the difference!
