



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Tips for Parents



Get the whole family involved in with just a few easy steps:

- **Demonstrate:** show and explain to children what kind of materials can be recycled and reused. Explain what material they are made of, also explain if some of the materials can be reused instead of being thrown in the recycling bin and then show them how to recycle properly.
- **Develop Understanding:** Show your children some examples of objects made from reused or recycled material, such as cardboards, plastic bottles, etc. You can explain how to reuse cardboard boxes to store items, or how waste materials can be used to create art projects. Why not challenge children to take some waste materials and be creative!
- **Provide Opportunities:** teach children to organise waste by the materials they are made from – clean cardboard, glass, aluminium, etc. and show how they should be recycled and which bins to use. Why not set up a recycling project in your home and give children points for recycling each week.
- **Discuss:** explain to your children the importance of recycling and reusing some materials and their impact on the environment. Answer any questions they may have about how to recycle properly at home.

Fun Activity for Young Learners

Match the item to the type of bin it should be put in! For each of the items below, colour them in which colour bin they should be placed in as follows:

- Colour the item in Green for the recycling bin
- Colour the item in Blue for the general waste bin
- Colour the item in Yellow for the composting bin
- Colour the item in Red for the glass bin



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
