Tips for Parents

Get the whole family involved in with just a few easy steps:

- **Demonstrate:** Show and explain to children the importance of water in our world. Explain to them how much water goes into making clothes, not only washing them!
- Develop Understanding: Explain to your children how different volumes of water are used to create different types of clothes and encourage them to see the benefits of buying clothes in a charity shop.
- Provide Opportunities: allow your children to select all their clothes that are in a good condition. Allow the same with the shoes. The clothes and shoes that you do not like, don't throw away, just donate them! Why not bring your children to a charity shop and see if they would like to buy some clothes from this shop, rather than buying new!
- Discuss: Explain to your children the materials that are used in clothes. Also, explain the best way of take care of clothes. If they take care of their clothes, they will last longer!

Fun Activity for Young Learners

Draw the jeans and shoes you and your family are wearing. Now beside each item, write the amount of water needed to create these items of clothes! Ask for help to look up the amount of water for each item if needed!









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
